POVERTY AND THIRD GIRL CHILD FORCES LADY TO BETRAY MOTHERHOOD

On 10/08/2020, a female baby just 8 to 10 days old was found abandoned on PF No. 7, Sarai Rohilla Rly Station. The baby was noticed by a passerby and Police was informed. An NGO was also called and the baby was got medically examined. Several teams were constituted under the supervision of SHOSH. Shri Krishan of PS Sarai Rohilla Railway Police Station. Verification from the hospital records as well as from the Aanganbari workers regarding the pregnancies and probable deliveries in the adjoining areas was conducted on massive scale. After hours and hours of search conducted, family was traced and mother has been identified as Hemlata, age 32 yrs w/o Pooran Chand, 40 yrs r/o D-784, J J Colony, Madi Pur, Delhi. Mother is house wife and father works in a shoe factory in Madipur. On enquiry it came to notice that the parents already had two daughters and this third baby was born on 2nd August 2020. After birth of the third female baby, mother Hemlata had become so mentally upset that she tried to harm herself too. Not succeeding in that, and with disturbed mind she left her home along with baby and reached SRRS and left the baby on the PF thinking that some body will take the baby and adopt. She repented after the counselling by the NGO and police. Family members were also called and after ensuring the safety, the baby was handed over.

- Inter-State Gang of ATM Card Cloners Arrested by Railway Unit of Delhi Police
- Kingpin, an Engineering Graduate
- Forty one ATM Cards Recovered
- Two Card Cloning Machines recovered
- Twenty Thousands Cash recovered

On 02.08.2020, a team of PS New Delhi Railway Station led by SHO and ATO apprehended two persons namely:-

1. Anil Kumar, age 26 years s/o Rajbir Singh r/o Village- Sisai, PS-Hansi, Distt-Hisar, HR, present address E-7/135, Sultanpuri, Delhi
2. Vinod Kumar , age 39 years s/o Dhanpal Singh r/o Village –Lahari Jatu, PS – Bawani Khera, Distt, Bhiwani, HR

belonging to interstate of gang of ATM Card cloners and duping innocent persons going to ATM for cash withdrawal. Forty one (41) ATM cards, two ATM cards cloning devices and 20 thousand rupees cash were recovered from their possession. In this regard a case vide FIR No. 19/20, dated 02.08.20, u/s 411/413 /34 IPC has been registered at PS New Delhi Railway station and both the persons have been arrested in the case.

INCIDENT:

In view of the forthcoming Independence day- 2020, checking has been beefed up and close watch is being kept on the movements of passengers, arriving and departing from New Delhi Railway Station through CCTV as well as by physically deploying staff at the platforms. On 02.08.2020, when Howrah Rajdhani Express arrived at New Delhi Railway Station, at around 10.25 AM, three suspicious looking persons were noticed. On seeing the staff, they started walking fast. The staff chased them and apprehended two of them while the third person who was walking few meters ahead of these two, managed to escape. The names of these two persons were revealed as:

1. Anil Kumar, age 26 years s/o Rajbir Singh r/o Village- Sisai, PS-Hansi, Distt-Hisar, HR, present address E-7/135, Sultanpuri, Delhi.

2. Vinod Kumar, age 39 years s/o Dhanpal Singh r/o Village –Lahari Jatu, PS – Bawani Khera, Distt, Bhiwani, HR.

The name of third person who managed to escape was revealed as Ravi, age 30 years r/o Sultanpuri, Delhi.

RECOVERY:

On checking their bags, 41 ATM cards of different banks and two ATM cloning Machines and twenty thousands rupees were recovered.

INTERROGATION/MODUS OPERANDI:

The sustained interrogation of these arrested persons revealed that the absconded third person namely Ravi is brother-in-law of accused Anil, the kingpin of this racket. Ravi has studied engineering in 2008 from Rohtak. He is basically from Bhiwani, Haryana. Presently, he is residing at Sultanpuri, Delhi. His father is a Junk dealer. He has earlier been arrested in five cases of ATM fraud in Delhi in 2018. He recruited accused Anil and Vinod into this racket. These accused used to travel to different parts of the country (Delhi, Gujarat, Mumbai, Bihar, Jharkhand, UP, West Bengal, Rajasthan) to cheat innocent persons who used to come to ATM Booths for withdrawing cash. They used to wait for users at the ATM booths which were not guarded and targeted poorly educated persons who are not comfortable in using ATM cards. Ravi was using two cloning devices which were purchased using online platform. He used these devices to copy the data of ATM cards. When a person/victim came to ATM booth they would see the PIN and on pretext of helping that person Ravi swiped the credit card through the device and copied the information available on the magnetic strip into memory of ATM card. That information was subsequently copied to a counterfeit card, complete with security holograms and then with this cloned ATM card money was withdrawn. Accused Ravi was also using MSR App on his mobile to write the data copied to a bogus card. Accused Vinod is also involved in similar type of crime in 2018 in Bhiwani district. Accused Anil is a pick pocketer. The recovered ATM cards were used in two ways; firstly if they get a chance they interchange the ATM card of the victim with the card of the same bank available with them and secondly for transferring copied data to these cards which then becomes a cloned card. In the past Ravi and his gang have duped hundreds of innocent persons and cheated them of lacs of rupees using this modus operandi.

PROFILE OF THE ACCUSED PERSONS:

Accused Anil Kumar is 26 years old. He is married and having three children. He is 12th pass. He is a pick-pocket. Accused Vinod is married and also having three children. He is 10th pass. He has earlier been involved in the case of ATM fraud.

- **MOBILES STOLEN . LOCKDOWN . COULDN'T SELL . CAUGHT**
- **TWO SNATCHERS INCLUDING ONE CCL ARRESTED**
- **SNATCHED MOBILE PHONE RECOVERED**
- **TEN OTHER STOLEN MOBILE PHONES ALSO RECOVERED**

The staff of PS Old Delhi Railway Station, Railways Unit has arrested snatcher namely Gautam S/o Shambhu R/o Jhuggi Tokri Valan, DRP Line, Delhi, Age-23 Years, and apprehended one CCL. One snatched mobile phone and 10 other stolen mobile phones were also recovered.

INCIDENT:

An incident of Snatching was reported at PS Old Delhi Railway Station in the night of 28.05.2020 in which two persons snatched one mobile phone (make Honor) in a running train bound for Jammu, near Sadar Bazar Railway Station and jumped out of the moving train despite the victim trying to get hold of them. Accordingly, a case FIR No. 09/20 u/s 356/379/34 IPC was registered at PS Old Delhi Railway Station.

TEAM CONSTITUTED:

A team led by Insp. Satinder Rathee, SHO/ODRS and consisting of ASI Mohanan, HC Rajneesh, Ct. Monu Yadav, Ct. Deepak, and Ct. Ashok was constituted under the supervision of Sh. Mahender Kumar, ACP/ODSD.

SURVEILLANCE:

The stolen mobile phone was kept under electronic surveillance and local intelligence was also pressed into operation. On the basis of information so collected and developed about the accused persons, on 29.05.2020, a trap was laid near Sadar Bazar Railway Station and accused persons were arrested. During interrogation, accused was identified as, Gautam S/o Shambhu R/o Jhuggi Tokri Valan, DRP Line, Delhi Age 23 yrs, the other accused has been a

CCL aged 17 years. The snatched mobile phone was recovered from accused Gautam and they confessed their involvement in the crime.

PROFILE OF THE ACCUSED PERSON:

Accused, Gautam is an illiterate and committing crime for his living. Both are friends and to earn easy and quick money they started committing crime.

“TIME WATCH WAS STOLEN – TIME WATCH MAKE THEIR BAD TIME.”

INCIDENT:

A foreigner couple, resident of U.K. while boarding train (Gatiman Express) to Agra from platform no.4 at Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station noticed their bag stolen containing passport, driving license, credit cards and other valuable articles. A case FIR No. 10/2020 was lodged u/s 379 IPC at Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station in this regard.

SURVEILLANCE:

In view of the few incidents of bags being stolen from trains at the Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station, a team was constituted under the supervision of SHO/HNRS, consisting of ASI Harpal Singh, 39/Rly, Const. Sunil 249/Rly., Const. Surender, 245/Rly. and Const. Dinesh, 362/Rly. was assigned the task of scanning CCTV cameras installed inside and outside the Railway Station. Meticulous scanning bore fruit and few persons entering station in suspicious circumstances were noticed. They were stopped and enquired about their presence. Their unsatisfactory answers did not convince the police.

DETAILS OF ACCUSED:

Three persons out of four of this gang have been arrested. Detail's of the gang members arrested are as follow:-

COACH VIOLATES 'GURU ETHICS', ARRESTED FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT.

INTRODUCTION:

A 19 years girl representing Haryana at the West Bengal Classic Boxing Championship, 2020, raped by the coach – Sandeep Malik, who was accompanying the team in the championship.

In her complaint, the 19-year-old boxing player has alleged that the coach Sandeep Malik and other team members left for Kolkata to participate in the West Bengal Classic Boxing Championship, 2020 by Duronto Express on February 27 from New Delhi Railway Station. She went to represent Haryana in the tournament. Meanwhile, the coach of the team, Sandeep Malik, raped her in the train and also while they were staying in Kolkata.

A case u/s 354A/376 IPC was registered at PS New Delhi Railway Station after receipt of the complaint of one 19 yrs old girl (name withheld). Her statement u/s 164 was recorded wherein she reaffirmed her allegations. Thereafter on 16/3/2020 the accused Sandeep Malik aged about 28 years old was arrested from Sonipat, Haryana.

During interrogation accused coach Sandeep Malik admitted the sexual assault. He runs a boxing academy at Sonipat. He has represented India in Boxing and gives coaching to the players who play at National level. He is married and has two children.

- **Two kidnappers arrested in Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Police Station**
- **Infant aged 2 months safely recovered.**

INCIDENT

On 25/12/2019, Smt. Rajkumari W/o Sh. Tota R/o Village Maihar Distt Satna MP was travelling from Hazrat Nizamuddin Rly Stn to Satna by Mahakaushal Express alongwith her daughter aged four and son barely two months old namely Dhruv.

Being illiterate and working as manual labour, she could not identify the correct platform and went to platform number two instead of one. She was pointed out her mistake and to rush fast she handed her son to a lady waiting there and first shifted her baggage and daughter to platform no. one and while she came back to take her son, that lady had vanished.

She looked for her son and the lady for quite some time and then approached police. A case FIR No 112/19, dt. 25/12/2019 U/s 363 IPC was registered in Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Police Station.

A team was constituted under the close supervision of ACP/Railways Smt. Meera Sharma and led by Insp. Praveen Kumar, SHO/HNRS consisting of Insp. Shivcharan Meena ATO/HNRS, ASI Harpal Singh No. 39/Rly, HC Kaushalendra Kumar No. 15/Rly, HC Naveen No. 1973/C, HC Sanjay Kumar No. 1617/NW, Ct Surendar No. 245/Rly, Ct Mandip No. 507/Rly and W/Ct Ravina No.479/Rly. The CCTV footage of the platform and entry and exit gates were scanned and two ladies near the complainant were identified. Based on the technical surveillance not only their mobile numbers were traced, one of them boarded the train to Madgaon (Goa) was also found out. The other lady had come to see her off. Movement of this lady confirmed her elopement with the

complainant's son. She first went to Moradabad and then to Panchkula, Haryana.

The boy was recovered safely by the team and the lady identified as Kavita was arrested alongwith her husband Dinesh, while they were trying to board the train to Goa.

The details of the accused are as follows:

1. Accused (1) Kavita W/o Dinesh R/o House No 8-A /3 Karaswada Mapusa, Bardez North Goa, presently Residing at Pali Ka Makan Mogi Nand Sect 30 Panchkula Haryana.
2. Accused (2) Dinesh S/o Raghbir S/o House No 8-A /3 Karaswada Mapusa, Bardez North Goa. Presently Residing at Pali Ka Makan Mogi Nand Sect 30 Panchkula Haryana (husband of Kavita)

They married a few years back and did not have any child out of their marriage and desperately wanted to have a child. They succeeded to get one at the cost of humanity, trust and the motherhood of other woman. They got the opportunity when out of trust a woman handed her son for safe custody, just for few minutes, but shattering her trust they fled away.

- **Interstate Gang of seven robbers visiting Delhi from Bihar to commit Crime in Trains nabbed.**
- **Looted property worth 20 Lacs recovered.**

INTRODUCTION:

On the basis of intelligence developed by the team of New Delhi Railways Police Station, a gang of thieves committing crimes in moving trains was nabbed by a team constituted under the close supervision of ACP/Railways Smt. Meera Sharma and led by Insp. Jitender Kumar SHO/NDRS consisting of ASI Pramod, HC Jaibir Singh, Ct Rahul, ASI Dal Chand, Ct. Vijay, Ct. Ram Karan from Entry Gate Pahar Ganj side and at platform No. 6 & 7 of New Delhi Railways station, when they were waiting for the trains to commit the crime.

DETAILS OF ACCUSED:

Seven persons of these gangs have been arrested. Detail's of the gang members arrested are as follow:-

1. Subodh Kumar S/o Ramesh Bhagat R/o Vill- Rajpura ,PS-Mufsil Distt- Begesarai, Bihar, Age-24 Yrs

MODUS OPERANDI

During interrogation that stated that they belong to Begu Sarai, Bihar and used to come to Delhi for committing thefts in trains and stayed in Hotels in Pahar Ganj, Delhi. They targeted long distance trains passing through New Delhi Railway Station. They used to enter the train compartments carrying luggage and pretending to be travelers. As the train started moving, they used to get down stealing after passenger's baggage. Other modus operandi was that they used to reece the platform after buying platform tickets and whenever they noticed passengers carrying hand bags etc standing at the gates while the trains used to slow down before stopping they snatched the bags and fled away. They used to sell the good so stolen to their accomplices in Bihar. One receiver Chandan @ Banti who had come to receive the stolen goods was also arrested.

SURVEILLANCE:

In view of the few incidents of bags being stolen from trains while stopping at the New Delhi Railway Station, the team was assigned the task of scanning CCTV cameras installed inside and outside the Railway Station. Meticulous scanning bore fruit and few persons entering station with baggage and coming out of station with different sets of baggage raised suspicious and further information was developed on their movement. After getting nabbed, the stolen articles were received from them.

- **2 snatchers/thieves arrested in PS Sarai Rohilla Railway Station.**
- **'Lucky charm' Mobile phone recovered.**

INTRODUCTION:

On 27.11.2019, SI Vikram Singh along with HC Shambhu Prasad No. 208/Railway and Ct. Sunit Kumar No. 215/Rly while on patrolling at Daya Basti Railway Station found 2 persons at the end of platform in suspicious circumstances. Both were stopped and enquired about their presence at a deserted and dark place. Their evasive and unsatisfactory answers, did not convince the police. They tried to flee away but were apprehended and searched. One mobile phone was recovered from their possession. Surprisingly, it did not have the SIM card. When the details of mobile phone was checked with the available computer records, it was found to be stolen in case FIR No. 61/2018, dated 29.10.2018, U/s 379 IPC, PS Sarai Rohilla Railway Station. Their interrogation revealed that after stealing this mobile phone, they had not been arrested in any case and this phone used to be their 'Lucky charm'. They never used this mobile phone for the fear of being detected during surveillance and not even inserted any SIM card.

INTERROGATION OF ACCUSED:

During interrogation they stated that both of them belong to Bhiwani District of Haryana and known to each other since years. Both are married in Sultanpuri and whenever they visit Delhi they reside in the house of their Father-in-Laws. Since 2 years, both have been committing theft in trains in the area of Nangloi to Kishangunj. Both the accused persons have mostly committed the theft of mobile phones from Railway passengers. Soon after committing theft they used to sell the mobile phones.
